Concerning the launching of a Competitive entrance examination and to set up the number of places into the 1st year of the Institute of Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences of the University of Douala at Yabassi, for the 2014/2015 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION HEBERY INFORMS:

Candidates who are holders of baccalaureate C, D, I or equivalent;

Candidates who are holders of GCE / AL obtained as follows:

- GCE/AL in Biology and Chemistry and Physics or Mathematics;
- GCE/AL in Biology and Chemistry on condition that the candidate obtained both papers

in one session, and had the GCE / Ordinary Level in Mathematics or Physics;

- Candidates who are holders of any other diploma accepted by the Ministry of Higher Education as equivalent,

That a competitive examination for the recruitment of one hundred (100) students, of which twenty (20) civil servants, ten (10) foreigners, into the first year of the Institute of the Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences of the University of Douala at Yabassi has been launched in Douala, Dschang, Yabassi, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé Centers. It comprises a study of file and written papers.

The study of file (coefficient 1) consists in the candidate's results in the Probatoire or GCE/OL, Baccalaureate or GCE/AL.

The written examination comprises:

- two hours Biology paper (coefficient 2);
- two hours Physics -Chemistry paper (coefficient 1);
- two hours Mathematics paper (coefficient 1).

The examination syllabus is that of Baccalaureate C, D and I or GCE/AL in Biology, Physics-Chemistry and Mathematics.

Application files include the following documents:

a) For candidates resident in Cameroun regularly registered in schools and civil servants

N.B: The candidates without certificate can be accepted to write with awaiting results

- a duly stamped hand-written application;
- an identification form to be collected at the ISH's liaison office, door 10 IUT (Douala); at the student's affair office of the ISH (Yabassi), FASA (Dschang), ESMV (Ngaoundéré) and CRESA Forêt-Bois (Yaoundé) or from the website: www.ish-univ-douala.com, www.univ-douala.com/ish
- certified true copies less than six months of the birth certificate;
- certified true copies of the required diplomas ;
- five (5) passport size photographs (4×4);
- a medical certificate delivered by a medical doctor of state administration, testify that the candidate is physically fit for university studies;
- transcripts of Probatoire or GCE/OL and Baccalaureate or GCE/AL;

- a receipt of payment of the sum of 20, 000 CFA francs into account of Institute of Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences of the University of Douala at Yabassi n° 10033 05214 140160 00004-94 at UBA, representing the registration fees;
- Two (2) A4 stamped self-addressed envelopes.

b) For foreigners candidates

All documents required on alinea a), they are admitted after study of their file. Complete files are awaited in the following admissions offices: - The Rectorate of the University of Douala (*Service Courrier*); - Institute of Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences of the University of Douala at Yabassi (*Service de la Scolarité*); or send to the e-mail address: infos.ish@univ-douala.com

For all candidates, complete application files must reach before the **24th of July 2014** in the admissions Office of:

- The Rectorate of the University of Douala (*Service Courrier*);
- Institute of Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences of the University of Douala at Yabassi (*Service de la Scolarité*);
- Faculty of Agronomy and Agricultural Sciences (FASA) of the University of Dschang (*Service du Courrier*);
- School of Sciences and Veterinary Medicine (ESMV) of the University of Ngaoundéré;
- CRESA Forêt- Bois Yaoundé (*Secrétariat du Coordonnateur*).

Only candidates who have submitted a complete application file shall be authorised for the examination. They should therefore bring along their national identity cards.

Candidates for the competitive entrance examination into the first year should not be more than twenty five (25) years old on 1st January of the current year for those registered on schools or universities and forty five (45) years old for civil servants candidates.

The examination will take place on the **25th July 2014**, as from 8 A.M. in the following Centres:

- Douala (University of Douala) ;
- Yabassi (Institute of Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences);
- Dschang (Faculty of Agronomy and Agricultural Sciences);
- Ngaoundéré (School of Sciences and Veterinary Medicine);
- Yaoundé (CRESA Forêt-Bois).
